With hunt season winding down the Preserve Staff is still hard at work. We will start our annual cleanup process from hunt season starting off by picking up our cabana furniture followed by burning off zones across the ranch. We run three fully staffed fire trucks and a four-wheeler to accomplish this task. Burning off more than 3,000 acres

in less than a couple weeks' time is always a very strategic process. Picking the right days to burn with certain wind directions, the timing with high potential of rain and areas starting to green up, we must get it wrapped up in a timely manner.

Our lawns are starting to green up and we will have our full fleet of mowers out and about making sure the lawns are clipped to perfection. With the spring rains we are also working hard to get our food plots planted for the upcoming deer season. Our milo plots will not go in till later in the spring.



Fishing at the ranch is just starting to get underway. We are hauling boats out to our three fishing locations across

the ranch. With this, it is time to start filling fish feeders to get the wipers back on their scheduled feed times, fattening them up and building muscle, to not only stack on the weight, but to increase the fight at the end of the line. Guides will be spending time prepping their boats, rigging their rods with new line and stocking up on new tackle. Not only is the weather heating up but so is the fishing. 

2021 KANSAS FITASC / 5-Stand CHAMPIONSHIPS

Mark your calendar and plan on having a fantastic time while shooting cases of shotgun shells the weekend of May 13th-16th as Flint Oak will be host these two GREAT events. World Class Targets, Great food, Live Entertainment and Comradery will all be in abundance. This event is held at different Shooting Sports facilities across Kansas annually, and the shooters of Kansas voted once again for Flint Oak to host it.

The 4-day action packed event will start on Thursday May 13th with GP Trap Cup 100 sporting clay event and Small Gauge and Super Sport, the Small gauge course will run through 2 pm Sunday.

Early Friday morning the Greenwood Stocks Preliminary 100 Sporting clay event will start and will give the competitors two days to get warmed up and find their groove. The Main events will kick off early Saturday morning the 15th when they will be shooting 50 FITASC and 50 5-Stand targets daily Saturday and Sunday for 100 total per event.

Another event running on Saturday is our annual signature shoot the Oakley Cup, which will ensure the

competitors have plenty to keep them busy. On Sunday our annual Wildcat Cup will be open to all competitors and the public to enjoy. for each course daily 200 targets, or \$275.00 for the total 400 targets at both facilities and the chance for the prize money and awards.


This will be a Fun Easy weekend to get your required 300 registered targets in to compete in both of the Kansas Championships held later in the year.

Nonresident Deer Permits

APPLICATION PERIOD: April 1– 30, 2021

For all Out of State Hunt Member to hunt at Flint Oak, you must first apply for and receive a deer permit from Kansas Department of Wildlife Parks & Tourism.

Applicants must apply online, ksoutdoors.com or by phone, **1-800-918-2877**.

All fees will have an internet convenience fee added at time of applying online for a permit or preference point. You will also need to purchase a nonresident hunting license:

\$97.50 (16 and over) \$42.50 (15 and younger)

Bag Limit (1) White-tailed deer – buck, doe or fawn
and (1) White-tailed antlerless deer
No additional fee required,
included with White-tailed deer permit.

The deadline for applying is **APRIL 30, 2021**.

The state of Kansas reduced the spring turkey tags from two down to just one tag for the 2020 season and will remain at one tag for the 2021 season. This change was implemented due to a big decrease in populations across the state. Here at Flint Oak we also saw the reduction in mature toms. While we did have successful hunts last season, we decided to stop our season at the end of April in hopes to allow the remaining toms to successfully reproduce and see more birds the following season. We are keeping an eye on our populations to determine if we will offer any hunts this spring.

Although we all have turkey hunting on our minds, we are also spending time working toward next year's deer season. Even though deer season is over, now is the time to go into those bedding areas and find the hottest travel routes to hang stands for the up-and-coming season. We still run trail cameras into the off season and are very excited to see the mature bucks still on camera and working towards producing even larger racks for the up-and-coming deer season.

Flint Oak has the protein program back up and going in full force and is getting ready to plant food plots again to watch some of these bucks stack on the inches. After seeing success in last years feed program, we are branching out into some new areas on the ranch to provide more protein to more deer.

We are always searching for ways to improve our deer program to help put you on the buck of a lifetime!



course even if not required by law.

Remember, anyone born on or after July 1, 1957 must be certified by an approved course in hunter education before they can hunt in Kansas with the exception of anyone 15 years old and under may hunt without hunter education

Flint Oak's 39th Annual Hunter Education Weekend

Flint Oak will conduct the 39th annual Hunter Education course on August 14 and 15, 2021 with the help of the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism and our local conservation officer.

This course consists of outdoor hands on instruction that allows students to become more involved in the learning process. During these sessions, students will be taught history of firearms, firearms basics, ammunition, basic gun safety, hunter responsibility, ethics, and fair chase, field safety and bow hunting. Included are lessons on conservation and wildlife management, wildlife of Kansas, outdoor emergencies, Kansas hunting regulations and boating safety for hunters. The course will run all day on Saturday and half a day on Sunday. After completing the session work, the students will be given a box of shells

if they would like to "PRACTICE" what they have learned at Flint Oak's 5-Star rated Sporting Clay Course on Sunday afternoon.

The age requirement to become certified in hunter education is 11 years of age. The hunter safety course may be taken by those under the age of 11, on space available basis, but will be required to take the course

again upon reaching the age of 11. There is no charge for the course and everyone is encouraged to take the

certification provided that they are under the direct supervision of an adult 18 years old or older who has completed a hunter education course. A one-time deferral of the Hunter Education requirements may be acquired by individuals 16 and older by purchasing an Apprentice hunting license. Holders of Apprentice hunting licenses must hunt under the supervision of a licensed hunter age 18 or older. Under Kansas Law, Hunter Education Certification issued by any state, Canadian Province and some foreign jurisdictions are also deemed to meet the Hunter Education requirements.






Individual and Corporate Membership By-Laws

Flint Oak offers four kinds of hunt memberships, Individual, Corporate (multiple), Junior or Senior.

INDIVIDUAL (Single designee)

Individual Memberships shall be issued in the name of an individual or in the name of a business or firm. Individual Memberships are assigned to one (1) designated individual and are non-transferable. The designee of an Individual Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

CORPORATE (Multiple designees)

Corporate Memberships shall be issued either in the name of a company or an individual associate of a professional group. A company is understood to be any entity holding a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN). Such named entity (whether a company or an individual associate) shall be designated as the Owner of the Membership, and the rights and privileges of the Membership are the property of the named Owner. The first Designee appointed by the Owner of the Membership shall be responsible for and billed for all charges incurred by designees and their guests.

Corporate Memberships include membership rights and privileges for three (3) designated individuals. The first Designee shall be Flint Oak's contact for billing purposes. All designees must be directly employed by said company or an associate of the same firm as the Owner of the Membership. Designees may be changed at no charge provided the Owner of the Membership notifies Flint Oak in writing of the substitution.

JUNIOR (Single designee)

Junior Memberships, for those between the ages of twenty-one and forty, require current Hunt Member sponsorship, are assigned to one (1) designated individual and are non-transferable. The designee of a Junior Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

SENIOR (Single designee)

Senior Memberships are available to our current members, who have been a member for the previous five years and are 70 years of age or older. Membership is assigned to one (1) designated individual and is non-transferable. The designee of a Senior Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

Dues and Charges

1. Membership dues, regardless of Membership type, shall be paid in advance. Hunt Membership dues will establish membership for one year from the date of acceptance.
2. All monthly charges will be due the tenth of the month following the month such charges were incurred.
3. Members will be responsible for any charges and/or damages incurred by their guests. Guests will have no billing privileges.
4. Members will be billed monthly. Payments to be made by check or ACH payments (no credit cards.)
5. Corporate Membership billings will be to one designated Member, and will not be broken down to individual designee charges.
6. Hunt credits and/or services included with the initial membership fee must be used during the months of membership. They do not carry over to another membership year, nor are such unused services subject to refund at the conclusion of the membership. Social Memberships receive no hunt credits.

On a Corporate Membership the first Designee or his assigned should collect and forward any moneys paid in order to keep the account accurate. Flint Oak will consider the corporate membership as one account and cannot credit individuals in that account as well as assign hunt credits to individuals in that account. All monies received will be applied to earliest invoices.

The Corporate Membership rate is extended due to the reduction in bookkeeping on one account rather than three individual accounts.



3rd Annual at Flint Oak

September 24-25th, Flint Oak is honored to be part of this great event again helping America's Veterans make the trip to our Nation's Capital.

The Honor Flight Network is a Nationwide, non-profit organization created solely to honor America's Veterans for all their sacrifices. The national network presently has 127 hubs in 41 states, eight of which are hosted by Kansas high schools, of which one is found at

Parsons High School with the help of their friends at USD 505 Chetopa-St. Paul. The goal of the program is to send Veterans on an all-expense paid trip to Washington, DC to visit their memorials where they reflect at their memorials. Top priority is given to the senior veterans – World War II survivors, along with those other Veterans who may be terminally ill.

Korean and Vietnam Wars Veterans are also represented on Flights.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

FISHING REMINDERS

Fishing is April 1st through October 31st. Catch and release only for Bass and Wipers. See fishing rules. During these months fishing for overnight guests and Social Members is at Center Lake, Duck Pond, along the creek and Lodge Lake from the silo to the windsock. Indian Lake is not included. During the month of September fishing lakes may be booked as long as no European or Field Hunts are scheduled in the vicinity.

During fishing season Flint Oak rental boats are permitted on Center Lake. No boats are allowed on Lodge Lake or Timber Lake due to the shot fall from Sporting Clays. We are very concerned about contamination of our water by zebra mussels or other invasive species. Under no circumstances will boats not owned by Flint Oak be allowed on any of the lakes or the creek. No waders allowed. Artificial bait only in the lakes, barbless hooks required

All activities at Flint Oak require ADVANCE RESERVATIONS. We limit the reservations we accept to the personnel and facilities we have available. Unlike the airlines, WE DO NOT OVERBOOK! If we accept your reservation, we guarantee that we will have everything required for your activities (just like buying a ticket to a ballgame). We are located "deep in the country" and do not have passer-by business. Our food orders and personnel schedules are made weekly and must be based on advance reservations.

Once your reservation is booked, we incur the expense of whatever advance ordering and planning are required. So if you fail to come, or cancel after the expense of preparations has been incurred, what is fair? Should all guests be penalized by increased charges to cover these expenses? Most of our guests believe it is fairer to charge a cancellation fee to those who create the increased cost!

ROOM CANCELLATIONS

Room (meeting or lodging) reservations made for NON-HUNT/FISHING RELATED activities require a first-day deposit per room for non-members to guarantee reservations. Rooms may be canceled at NO CHARGE twenty-four (24) hours in advance. Cancellations twenty-four (24) hours or less will be charged the full amount per room per day reserved unless other arrangements have been made in writing by management.
